Brainiac at S.H.S.

Tucked away in the recesses of Room 611 is a unique system which goes generally unnoticed by the average student, the computer.

The computer system, which involves one computer and 5 Telex machines, was purchased for use five years ago at a cost of nearly \$17,000. This system, however, has returned that sum many times over in its service to Stamford High School.

Miss Sandra Wiener, the computer's master mind, uses the systems in teaching computer programming, computerized instruction of math related courses, and in many miscellaneous services such as compiling the results for The Round Table presidential poll. Without Miss Wiener and the computer's help, the results of the poll would have to be determined by hand, taking up to a month

instead of the five days in which the responses were tallied.

Although this system has many remarkable advantages, it also has a number of inefficiencies. The past four years have been a losing battle in Miss Wiener's quest to acquire new equipment. As the system stands now, it is impossible to conduct successive chores with the computer because by the time the suitable information is loaded into it, the time is up. A magnetic tape or disc system would provide an expanded memory, increased processing speed, and more flexibility to meet varied needs.

With this magnetic tape system, information would not have to be stored on inefficient, inaccurate paper tape and the computer's usefulness would be expanded tremendously. The new system would allow the computer to increase its services in many areas, such as keeping media center inventory, attendance records, and book inventory for specific departments.
